

# King County Fire Protection District #47 MENINGITIS EXPOSURE GUIDELINE

Meningococcal (Neisseria Meningitidis)

**CONTACT: Department Health & Safety Officer (DH&SO)**

**DH&SO Responsibility:**

1. Verify that treatable exposure has occurred.
2. Consider notifying Admin Staff and Fire Chief.

**IF EXPOSURE RISK  
IS PRESENT**

Administer one (1) Cipro (500mg)  
to each exposed individual.  
(Contraindications: allergies,  
pregnant and/or nursing women,  
children, and renal patients.)

Notify other agencies if involved:  
PD, AMB, & SKCPH Epidemiology

**Each individual must fill out:**  
KCFPD #47  
EXPOSURE/CONTAMINATION FORM  
(Affix Cipro label to this form.)

DH&SO will notify Fire Chief  
and file forms in individual  
health records.
